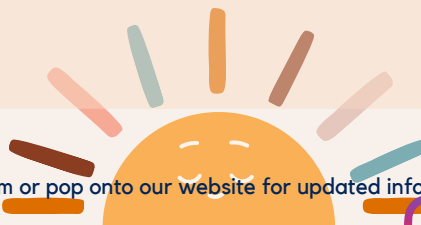

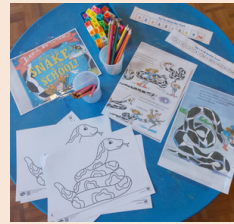

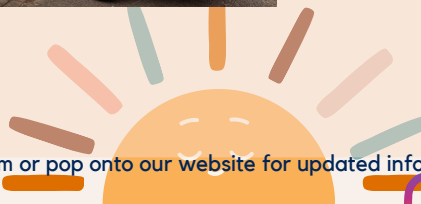

If you are deferring your child, please ensure you still accept the placement before the deferral request.

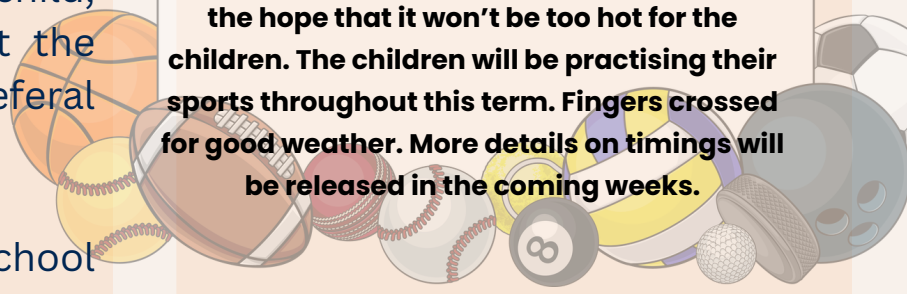

Allocation spaces have opened for September 2026 - 2027. An email with a link will be sent out shortly for all children that are returning. Please submit your session requests by Monday 11th May

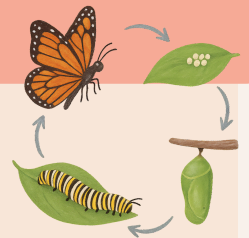
SPORTS DAY Friday 22nd May
